

Managing your ongoing SM&CR obligations with Redland

The March deadline for complying with the requirements of the SM &CR regime has come and gone and businesses are now faced with maintaining their compliance at a practical operational level. - 1. Do you feel confident that you could demonstrate to the regulator that you had a good understanding of the various systems and controls in your business area that serve as an input into your organisation’s risk management framework?**
- 2. Within your area of the business can you identify the means by which the key decisions, challenges, and debates are discussed and agreed, and also are you confident that these are in practice recorded and evidenced in a structured way in addition to formal meeting minutes?**
- 3. If required could you describe to the regulator how within your business area you practice effective oversight of both the conduct of staff and the risks posed by the relevant business functions?**
- 4. Could you describe the key mechanisms, processes and policy by which you ensure that all individuals to whom you delegate specific responsibility to are deemed competent to carry out such delegated responsibility?**
- 5. How in practical terms will you manage the certification process applicable to all certified staff in your business area?**
